## **Northwest Flag Football**

**PLAYERS** - Must be entering Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2019 to be eligible to play. Deadline to sign up is August 1, 2019. Teams will be divided by age: K/1<sup>st</sup> play together, 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> play together. **PLEASE NOTE 4<sup>th</sup> GRADE OPTIONS ARE STILL UNDER REVIEW AND NOT GUARANTEED AT THIS TIME!**

**PRACTICES** - All practices will be on Tues & Thurs nights from 6-7pm at **South Beal Park** in Maryville. Tentative start date (first practice) is August 6th. \*Once games start, it will be up to each team/coach if/when your team will practice. More information will be sent after registration is closed.

**GAMES** – **All games will be held at Donaldson Westside Park in Maryville.** Games will be held Tuesdays or Thursdays evenings and/or Sunday afternoons. If you are not scheduled for a Tuesday or Thursday game, each Coach will decide if their team will practice. Games will be approx. 40 minutes (2 – 20 minute halves with running clock and 5 minute break in between). Tentative start for games is September.

**COACHES** – **We highly encourage parents to volunteer to help coach their child's team. As you will quickly see at practice, the more help the better! If teams do not have at least 2 volunteers, we will spread the kids out on other teams. We try to avoid the teams getting too large, as we want the kids to play as much as possible.**

**TEAMS** – We will do our best to ensure that all teams consist of the same number of Kindergarteners/1<sup>st</sup> graders or 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> graders.

**REGISTRATION-** All registrations must be received NO LATER than July 31st! We will hold 1-2 open registration sessions (date/times TBA), OR forms and fee may be sent at any time. There will be a \$10 discount for any forms received by July 1<sup>st</sup>

- 1) We hope to attend the 1st home Bearcat game together as a league. The players and coaches will get to be on the field to form the tunnel/entrance for the Bearcats as they enter the field! Players/coaches will get in free, with tickets offered to families at a reduced price. More details will be available during the first weeks of practice.
- 2) During first weeks of practice we will be finalizing any family T-shirt orders and money collection to ensure we will have these for the first game. Please be prepared to pay for your purchases at the time of ordering.
- 3) Professional pictures will be taken early in the season (during practice time), with more information to follow.
- 4) One Mouth guard will be provided by the league. It is HIGHLY encouraged all players (especially older groups) wear these during practice/games. While tackling/contact is NOT allowed, accidents are possible and do happen. If player loses mouth guard provided, we will have extras available to purchase.
- 5) Once games begin, it will be up to the individual team/coach whether or not your team will practice during the week. Weather related decisions ONLY will be made by the league coordinators. If you have questions regarding practices etc, please contact your teams coach first.
- 6) The League Facebook Page, NW Flag Football, is our main source of communication. It allows us to reach the most people efficiently. Please request to be added to the page, and Admin will approve. This will be where all Admin info will be posted regarding changes/cancellations schedules and ALL other general info. Each coach will have a list to text their parents individually as well, but are not required to do so if changes are posted on FB page. Please check page frequently and feel free to post questions etc as well.
