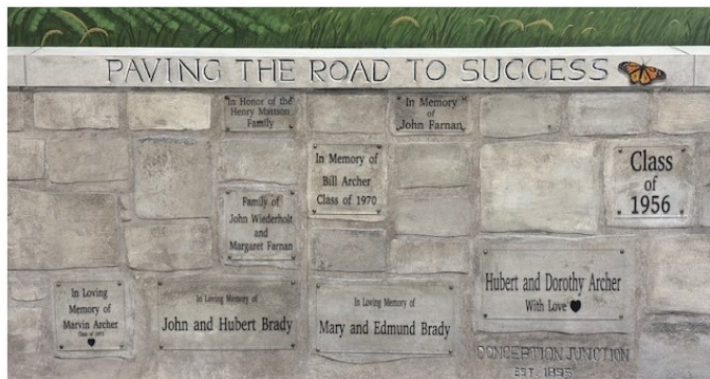
Jefferson’s “Paving the Road to Success” mural is located at the school entrance.
